Six years ago, the Mission Zimbabwe Project saw a real need to initiate an Education Fund. This fund enables students who have grown up and completed their primary and secondary education at the Village of Hope in Zimbabwe, to study at university or at a technical college, or to go on to post secondary opportunities which lead to employment opportunities. Over the course of the last few years the Mission Zimbabwe Education Fund has helped over 20 students with course fees, exam fees, laptop computers and Internet bundles which allowed the students to continue their studies online through the COVID-19 pandemic.
